Re: Parents Right to Know Information

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Your child's school receives Federal Title I funds to assist students in meeting state proficiency standards. This correspondence is to inform you about your right to request professional qualifications of staff working with your child during the 2025-2026 academic year.

Schools receiving Title I funding must meet federal teacher qualification requirements as defined in the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA), as amended (2015). This legislation allows you to inquire about educator training and credentials. At any time, you may request the following information:

- If the teacher meets state qualifications and certification requirements for the grade level and subject the educator is providing educational services in
- If the teacher has received an emergency or temporary status in which Indiana qualifications were waived
- The undergraduate or graduate degrees the teacher holds, and major(s) or area(s) of concentration
- Whether your child receives educational services from a paraprofessional, and if so, the qualifications of paraprofessional

The Warrick County School Corporation (WCSC) is committed to providing educational opportunities that allow your child to develop the social, academic, and critical thinking skills necessary to be successful. If you would like to request information regarding the professional qualifications of the educator(s) or paraprofessional(s) working with your child, please contact the building administration at your school. We are looking forward to working with you to ensure that the 2025-2026 academic year is a success.
